



GET TO KNOW THE NUMBERS THAT ATTEST TO THE STANDARD OF LIVING OF THE TOBACCO GROWERS IN SOUTH BRAZIL COMPARED WITH THE AVERAGE IN BRAZIL.

The Federal University of Rio Grande do Sul, through its Study and Administration Research Center (CEPA/UFRGS) published the report on the results of the second edition of the research 'Socio-Economic Profile of the tobacco growers in the South Region of Brazil', conducted in 2023. Just like the first edition, conducted in 2016, the study was implemented at the request of the Interstate Tobacco Industry Union (SindiTabaco) and carried out from June 30 to July 20, 2023, and covered 37 municipalities where tobacco is produced in the South Regions of Brazil.

The research results point to good socioeconomic conditions of the tobacco growers in the South Region of Brazil: while 80% of the tobacco growers fall into the category of classes A and B, the general average in Brazil does not reach 25%. Furthermore, the monthly average per capita income of the tobacco growers is twice as much as the average in Brazil.

The tobacco growers have access to essential household items, as well as items related to hygiene and health products. What the research also ascertains is the fact that the tobacco growers are very satisfied with their status as growers and, in particular, proud to be tobacco growers. This ascertainment is ratified by their self-evaluation of their living standards.

The results reaffirm the economic and social importance of tobacco in the rural setting, destroying the tale that the tobacco growers endure vulnerability conditions. The pages that follow present a study that provides a series of information on the profile of the tobacco growers in the South Region of Brazil.
